

# A Word About The “Study Guide”

The “study guide” is just that - it’s a way for you to view the content of the quiz so you can familiarize yourself with the subject material.

You must get a 90% or better on the quiz to work at Lambeau. You only need to pass it once. You can take it as many times as needed to pass.

We aren’t posting the “study guide” as a way to cheat – just a way for you to view the content of the quiz so you can familiarize yourself with the subject material.



We would never suggest that you open the link to the quiz in one window and open the link to the “study guide” in another window at the same time and take the quiz that way. We would never suggest that.



The questions on the “study guide” are not in the same order that you’ll find when you take the actual quiz. Also, the order of the answers on each question might be different. So if you DID happen to do what we DIDN’T suggest above about having both windows/links open at the same time, make sure you pay attention. 😊

Once you pass the test (90% or above), you’ll need to print off your *Certificate of Completion* and bring it with you to the game you are volunteering at. Again, you only need to pass the quiz once, before the first game you volunteer at. Any other games you work at this season, you DO NOT need to take the quiz again.
